

What is IHE?

Integrating the Healthcare Enterprise (IHE) is an international not-for-profit organisation that enables healthcare IT system users and suppliers to work together to produce hard evidence of smooth healthcare workflow through:

- careful definition of healthcare delivery tasks (use cases)
- specification of essential task information to be exchanged using some provisions of existing international standards
- specification of essential task processes
- annual testing - **Connectathons** - of supplier software for conformance with the data exchange and process specifications

Our work is sponsored by various international bodies and individuals, who also contribute their time, funding and expertise to the development and smooth running of IHE operations both worldwide and nationally. IHE-UK is the National affiliate to IHE Europe.

IHE-UK Membership

Membership of IHE-UK is open to any individual or organization involved in or around healthcare. There are three classes of membership: Individual, Corporate and Benefactor. Individual membership subscription fees are paid in return for networking and educational benefits, but most importantly, the right - and indeed expectation - to participate in the work of the IHE-UK committees both on-line and face-to-face.

Professional associations and government agencies are invited to directly sponsor the work of IHE. Members work together in "Domain Committees" which align with the knowledge domains of IHE interest, such as IT Infrastructure or Medical Imaging. All committee voting is based on named individuals being present at meetings. The IHE-UK governance document can be accessed from www.ihe-uk.org.

Corporate Membership enables the use of the IHE-UK Corporate Member logo to signify corporate acceptance of and contribution to the work and vision of IHE. Corporate membership allows companies to transfer committee voting rights between employees and includes our promotion of the company name on the IHE-UK website.



In addition to corporate membership benefits, Benefactor Membership enables the use of the IHE-UK Benefactor Member logo to indicate that the organisation is investing additional funds and resources to develop IHE capabilities and scope of IHE profile deployment in the UK. Current benefactors include Accenture, The British Institute of Radiology and the British Computer Society.
